

TOPPS® BIG LEAGUE BASEBALL “TAKE THE FIELD” CONTEST

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. A PURCHASE WILL NOT IMPROVE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

By participating, you (on behalf of yourself and your minor child) agree to these Official Rules and Sponsor’s decisions, which are final and binding in all respects and not subject to appeal.

- 1. ELIGIBILITY.** Must be a legal resident of the 48 contiguous United States (including Washington, D.C.), of the age of majority in your place of residence, with a child (i.e., biological child, adopted child, step-child or foster child) who is between 10 and 15 years of age and actively enrolled in school (“Child”) (as of date of entry). Contest is void in Alaska, Hawaii, Puerto Rico, other United States Territories (including Guam) and where prohibited by law. Employees, officers and directors (and their immediate families, defined as a parent, child, sibling, or spouse as well as the spouse of a child or sibling, regardless of where they live, and same household members, whether related or not) of Sponsor, its parent, subsidiaries, affiliates, agencies and prize suppliers, retailers and distributors of Topps products, the MLB Entities (as defined below), or the MLBPA (as defined below) are NOT eligible. An individual will also be ineligible to win a prize if any of the following applies as of the date potential winners are selected: (a) he/she or his/her Child has been convicted of a felony or has felony charges pending against him or her; (b) he/she or his/her Child has been convicted of any crime (felony or misdemeanor) that Sponsor determines in its sole discretion involves drugs, domestic violence, or child endangerment or has charges of such crime pending against him or her; (c) he/she or his/her Child has an outstanding arrest warrant (felony or misdemeanor) against him or her; (d) he/she is subject to a restraining order; (e) his/her Child has been expelled from school for any reason. As a condition to winning a prize, potential winners will be required to represent and warrant in a winner’s affidavit that the foregoing conditions do not apply and they are eligible to win.
- 2. CONTEST PERIOD.** The Topps® Big League Baseball “Take the Field” Contest (the “Contest”) begins May 8, 2019, at 12:01 a.m. Eastern Time (ET) and ends September 2, 2019, at 11:59 p.m. ET (the “Entry Period”). ALL ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED DURING THE ENTRY PERIOD BY SEPTEMBER 2, 2019, AT 11:59 P.M. ET.
- 3. TO ENTER.**
 - (a) Visit the TOPPS website at www.topps.com/takethefield. First, complete the official entry form with your name, your age, the first name and age of your Child, your mailing address, and your e-mail address. Then, complete the questionnaire with your most compelling expression of your Child’s interest in Major League Baseball’s live T-Mobile Home Run Derby® event held during MLB All-Star Week™. For the avoidance of doubt, a parent/legal guardian enters his/her minor Child in the Contest;

the *parent/legal guardian* is the entrant. Accordingly, the minor Child SHOULD NOT attempt to enter the Contest him/herself.

- (b) The questionnaire consists of six (6) questions, all of which must be answered in English. The answer to each question cannot exceed the stipulated word count (as set forth in the questionnaire) and must be input in the designated text box of the questionnaire. (Answers cannot be continued or included anywhere other than the designated text box of the questionnaire; e.g., a file attachment.) **BE CAREFUL IN COMPLETING THE QUESTIONNAIRE BECAUSE ONCE SUBMITTED, ANSWERS CANNOT BE MODIFIED, EDITED, AMENDED OR SUPPLEMENTED.**
- (c) There is a limit of one (1) official entry form (including completed questionnaire) per eligible Child. If you have more than one (1) eligible Child, a separate official entry form must be submitted for each eligible Child. An entrant represents that he/she is the parent or legal guardian of the eligible Child, and, to his/her knowledge, no other individual has submitted an entry form on behalf of the same Child.
- (d) Receipt of entry may be acknowledged by Sponsor. Any such acknowledgment merely indicates that the entry has been received and is not otherwise binding upon Sponsor in any respect (including without limitation as a representation of Contest eligibility or selection of entrant as a prize winner in the Contest).
- (e) Proof of submission of entry/questionnaire does not constitute proof of receipt of same or proof of entry in the Contest.
- (f) No personal information will be knowingly collected from persons who are under 13 years of age in conjunction with participation in the Contest; personal information will only be collected from persons who are of the age of majority in their place of residence and thereafter used by Sponsor in accordance with Topps' Privacy Policy at www.topps.com/privacy-policy. You are advised to review Topps' Privacy Policy for full details as to Sponsor's information collection and usage practices.

4. **CONTENT OF ANSWERS.**

- (a) Answers must be truthful in all material respects. Do not misrepresent or exaggerate your Child's interest or responses.
- (b) Answers must be solely the original work of a single person (i.e., the parent/legal guardian who is entering his/her minor Child in the Contest), and must be created without third party assistance of any kind; answers cannot be entered by a group/team/association.
- (c) Answers must NOT include any content that (i) violates the rights of any third party (including trademark, copyright, right of publicity, right of privacy, defamation, libel); (ii) is inappropriate, offensive or otherwise unfit for publication (e.g., no

profanity or hate speech), or advocate or encourage alcohol, e-cigarettes, tobacco or drug use, acts of violence or illegal activity of any kind; (iii) disparages The Topps Company, Inc., any MLB Entity or MLBPA or adversely affects their goodwill or business reputation or disparages any Major League Baseball player, manager or coach (current or retired), Club or any other MLB Entity or the game of baseball; or (iv) is irrelevant to the questions posed in the questionnaire. Answers must have been created specifically for this Contest and must not have been previously published in whole or in part.

(d) Sponsor grants each entrant the limited, revocable, non-exclusive, royalty-free, non-sublicensable and non-transferable right to use its trademarks solely on the questionnaire for purposes of participation in the Contest in accordance with these Official Rules provided that all accompanying trademark ownership notices are properly retained therewith. Unless specifically exempted in writing by Sponsor, such grant of rights shall automatically expire at the end of the Contest. At all times, Sponsor shall remain as the sole owner of its trademarks; nothing herein is intended to constitute an assignment of ownership rights in any trademark of Sponsor.

5. **GRANT OF RIGHTS IN ANSWERS.** Entrant, on behalf of him/herself (as well as his/her Child, as appropriate):

(a) grants to Sponsor, the MLB Entities, MLBPA and each of their respective designees the exclusive, irrevocable, perpetual, worldwide, royalty-free, transferable, sublicenseable right and license to use, perform, exhibit, display, reproduce and/or otherwise exploit his/her answers in any manner, for any commercial or non-commercial purposes, and in any and all distribution channels, venues or media now known or hereafter devised, without further notice or any compensation to entrant (and/or his/her Child, as appropriate). Without in any way limiting the preceding, Sponsor may post an entrant's answers in whole or in part on www.topps.com, The Topps Company, Inc.'s social media pages, and perhaps elsewhere. (Should Sponsor choose to do so, such posting does NOT constitute any representation that such entrant is a potential prize winner in the Contest);

(b) waives any "Moral Rights of Authors" (*Droit Moral*) in his/her answers;

(c) agrees, upon the request of Sponsor, the MLB Entities and/or MLBPA, and without compensation, to sign any and all necessary and appropriate documents so as to effect, perfect or record the grant of license and/or waiver of "Moral Right of Authors" (*Droit Moral*) as per subsections (a) and (b) above;

(d) agrees that Sponsor, the MLB Entities, and MLBPA each have wide access to ideas, stories, designs and other literary/artistic materials submitted to each entity from outside sources or being developed by their own employees and that such ideas/stories/designs/literary/artistic materials may be competitive with, similar to (or even identical to) an entrant's answers and that Sponsor/the MLB

Entities/MLBPA shall have no liability to entrant, his/her Child or any third party in conjunction therewith; and

- (e) understands and agrees that Sponsor the MLB Entities, and MLBPA have no fiduciary duty, including any duty of confidentiality, to either the entrant or his/her Child, with respect to the content of his/her answers.

6. DETERMINATION OF PRIZE WINNERS.

(a) **Judging.** On or about September 18, 2019, a judging panel comprised of four (4) of Sponsor's marketing executives will evaluate the entries (i.e., sets of six (6) answers to the questionnaire) based on the following criteria: expression of Child's interest in/passion for the live T-Mobile Home Run Derby® event (60%); creativity and originality (30%); and grammar, syntax and overall clarity of expression (10%). The entrants whose sets of six (6) answers have the two (2) highest overall scores will be the potential prize winners. In the event of a tie, the tie will be broken by having the tied entrants' sets of answers evaluated by an additional judge using the above criteria.

(b) **Notification of Potential Winners.** The potential winners will be notified by e-mail and must (on their own behalf and on behalf of their Child) complete, sign and return an affidavit of eligibility, a liability release, a publicity release (where lawful) and other documents that may be required by Sponsor (including confirmation that their entries comply with these Official Rules) and/or MLBPA within five (5) business days of date indicated on prize notification. Prize will be forfeited without compensation and an alternate potential winner may be selected from among all remaining eligible entries/questionnaires received (i.e., the eligible entrant whose set of six (6) answers was ranked next highest in the judging) should any of the following occur:

- Potential winner fails to timely complete/sign/return affidavit of eligibility, a liability release and a publicity release (where authorized by law) on behalf of potential winner and his/her Child within the timeframe specified above;
- If potential winner cannot be contacted by Sponsor;
- Prize notification is returned as undeliverable;
- Potential winner declines the prize for any reason; or
- Potential winner is determined by Sponsor to be ineligible or otherwise in violation of these Official Rules.

7. **PRIZES.** Two (2) winners will each be awarded admission for winner and one (1) guest (i.e., the winner's Child upon whose interest the winner had completed the questionnaire) at the 2020 T-Mobile Home Run Derby® (the "Event") in Los Angeles, California, which is projected to take place on July 13, 2020; the opportunity for the winner to volunteer his/her Child to serve, together with other individuals, as a fly ball shagger in the outfield during a limited portion of the Event to be determined by the MLB Entities; two (2) round trip coach air travel tickets for winner and his/her Child between a major

commercial airport near winner's residence and Los Angeles, CA (unless winner lives within a reasonable, as determined by Sponsor at its sole discretion, driving distance to Los Angeles, CA, ground transportation will be provided in lieu of air travel tickets as set forth below; any difference in value will not be awarded); standard hotel accommodations (one (1) room, double occupancy) for two (2) days/one (1) night in a hotel of Sponsor's sole choosing near the ballpark where the Event is held ("Ballpark"); and ground transportation for winner and winner's Child from Los Angeles-area airport (or winner's residence) to hotel, from hotel to the Ballpark on the night of the Event, from the Ballpark to hotel, and from hotel to Los Angeles-area airport (or winner's residence). Total Approximate Retail Value ("ARV") per prize: \$2,500. If actual value of prize is less than \$2,500, winner will not receive the difference in cash (or otherwise). ARV of all prizes: \$5,000.

Each winner will be solely responsible for all other transportation and expenses not expressly provided for herein, including (without limitation), car rental or taxi fees, gasoline, parking, insurance, meals and beverages, in-room charges, gratuities, travel upgrades, baggage fees, and personal incidentals. In addition, Sponsor, MLBPA and the MLB Entities shall not be responsible for any additional charges resulting from any winner's or guest's changes to itinerary or accommodations. All travel and lodging will be at each individual's risk. Sponsor, the MLB Entities, and MLBPA maintain no control over the personal, equipment, or operation of any air carrier, ground transportation provider, hotel, or other person or entity furnishing services, products, or accommodations as part of any prize, and they shall not be liable for any injury, damage, loss, expense, accident, delay, cancellation, diversions or substitutions, or any act or omission, inconvenience or other irregularity that may occur.

Winner and winner's Child must be available to attend the Event; if winner and/or winner's Child cannot do so for any reason, the prize will be forfeited in its entirety and an alternate winner selected. PRIZE DOES NOT INCLUDE ADMISSION OR TICKETS TO OR FOR ANY GAME, EVENT OR EXHIBITION DURING THE 2020 MLB ALL-STAR WEEK™ OTHER THAN THE EVENT ITSELF. Nature of admission to the Ballpark for the Event is at the MLB Entities' sole determination and may not include seat access. Venue restrictions and other conditions may apply. Admissions are NOT for re-sale. Winner and winner's Child must travel on same itinerary (as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion, including airports and hotel). If winner lives within reasonable driving distance of Los Angeles, CA (i.e., within approximately 200 miles of Los Angeles, CA, with the definition of "reasonable" being determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion), ground transportation will be substituted for air travel and no compensation or alternate prize will be awarded. No frequent flier miles, travel awards or like "perks" are available in conjunction with prize travel. Valid government-issued photo identification required for air travel.

The nature and duration of the opportunity for winner's Child to serve as a fly ball shagger shall be determined by the MLB Entities and MLBPA, as applicable, in their sole discretion and subject to availability and the rules and regulations of the applicable MLB Entities and MLBPA, including winner's execution (on behalf of winner and winner's

Child) of a participant waiver and release. Winner's Child (and winner, to the extent applicable) must follow all instructions of MLB Entities/MLBPA in accepting the opportunity for winner's Child to serve as a fly ball shagger. It is not guaranteed that winner's Child will catch any fly balls, and Sponsor, MLB Entities, and MLBPA shall not have any liability relative to same. Any balls caught by winner's Child must be returned to MLB Entities and/or MLBPA unless winner's Child is otherwise instructed by authorized representative(s) of MLB Entities and/or MLBPA.

MLB Entities, MLBPA, and Sponsor make no representation or warranty that any specific player will participate in the Event. Prize does not include the receipt of any autograph or photograph from any Major League Baseball player, coach or manager and/or the opportunity to meet any Major League Baseball player, coach or manager. Opportunity to serve as a fly ball shagger may be modified, suspended or even cancelled altogether at the sole discretion of the MLB Entities/MLBPA due to scheduling, inclement weather, and/or other circumstances beyond the control of the MLB Entities/MLBPA, whether or not reasonably foreseeable; and, in such event, the liability of Sponsor shall be limited to the remaining elements of the prize (and with respect to the MLB Entities and MLBPA, they shall have no liability to winner and/or winner's Child). Winner's Child must wear acceptable attire (as determined by the MLB Entities/MLBPA in their sole discretion), and may not wear shoes with a cleated sole, as a pre-condition of serving as a fly ball shagger and is solely responsible for having a baseball glove with which to participate. Additional restrictions may apply to opportunity for winner's Child to serve as a fly ball shagger.

Opportunity for winner's Child to serve as a fly ball shagger is valid only for winner's Child and is not transferable. Winner (on behalf of winner and winner's Child) understands and agrees that winner and his/her Child both must act in an appropriate, well-behaved and courteous manner at all times while on the field (and at the Event and anywhere in the Ballpark). Without limiting the foregoing, winner's Child must at all times be respectful of other persons who are also in the outfield and/or attempting to shag balls. This includes but is not limited to winner's Child not pushing, kicking, shoving, punching, threatening or acting in an abusive manner toward other persons who are also attempting to shag balls. Should winner and/or winner's Child engage in improper conduct, Sponsor, MLB Entities, and/or MLBPA may eject winner and/or winner's Child from the Ballpark without liability of any kind (and if the improper conduct is egregious or blatant enough as determined by Sponsor/MLB Entities/MLBPA in their sole discretion, without warning of any kind); and, Sponsor, MLB Entities, and/or MLBPA may pursue legal sanctions against winner and/or winner's Child.

WINNER (ON BEHALF OF HIM/HERSELF AND HIS/HER CHILD) FURTHER UNDERSTANDS AND AGREES THAT NO ACCIDENT OR OTHER INSURANCE HAS BEEN OBTAINED BY SPONSOR, MLB ENTITIES, OR MLBPA FOR WINNER OR WINNER'S CHILD; AND, IF ANY SUCH INSURANCE IS DESIRED, PROCURING THE SAME IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF WINNER AT HIS/HER SOLE EXPENSE.

Event date and time are determined in the sole discretion of the BOC and/or the applicable Club, as applicable, and are subject to change. The terms and conditions of Event tickets will apply to and govern the Event admission awarded as prizes herein in the event the Event, as defined by Major League Baseball, is not played or held, as applicable, due to weather conditions, an act of God, an act of terrorism, civil disturbance or any other reason. Each winner and his/her Child agree to comply with all applicable ballpark and venue, as applicable, regulations in connection with the prize. Sponsor, MLBPA and the applicable MLB Entities reserve the right to remove or to deny entry to any winner and/or his/her Child who engage(s) in a non-sportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person at the Event. Sponsor, the MLB Entities and MLBPA will not be responsible for weather conditions, Acts of God, acts of terrorism, civil disturbances, work stoppage or any other natural disaster outside their control that may cause the cancellation or postponement of any Major League Baseball game, event or exhibition. Major League Baseball Event admissions awarded as prizes may not be sold or offered for sale or used for any commercial or promotional purpose whatsoever. Any such sale or commercial or promotional use may result in disqualification and prize forfeiture. The MLB Entities, MLBPA and Sponsor (i) make no warranty, guaranty or representation of any kind concerning any prize (or any portion thereof), and (ii) disclaim any implied warranty.

Limit of one (1) prize per family/household/e-mail address. (For the avoidance of doubt, if a given entrant has more than one (1) entry only the higher ranked of the entries (as per the judging in Rule 6(a)) will result in possible award of a prize with the other entry/entries being discounted.) Applicable taxes on prize are winner's sole responsibility and will be reported to the Internal Revenue Service via IRS 1099 Tax Form. Winner further agrees to fully cooperate with Sponsor as to its compliance with the IRS 1099 Tax Form requirement, including by providing his/her Social Security Number via IRS W9 Tax Form. All expenses not specified herein are winner's sole responsibility; such expenses include, by way of example only, costs of souvenirs, food/beverages, and other concessions.

Prizes are subject to availability and additional restrictions may apply. All details of prize unspecified herein shall be determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. Prizes are not transferable except with the prior written consent of Sponsor which may be withheld or granted without liability of any kind. No prize substitution or cash equivalent of prize.

Notwithstanding the above, Sponsor reserves the right to substitute the prize in whole or in part for an alternative prize of comparable value for any reason (including due to unavailability for any reason).

8. **RELEASES.** **By participating in the Contest, entrant (on behalf of him/herself and his/her Child) releases and agrees to hold harmless Sponsor, the MLB Entities, MLBPA, and each of their respective parent companies, affiliates, divisions, subsidiaries, associated entities and the directors, officers, agents, shareholders, representatives, employees, successors and assigns of any of the above organizations, as well as the owners and operators of the Event venue, the Event sponsor, Facebook, Instagram and Twitter, from any and all liability associated (directly or indirectly, in whole or in part) with entrant's participation in the Contest, entrant's participation in any Contest-related activity and receipt, acceptance, possession or use/misuse of any prize (as applicable), including without limitation claims based on death, illness, personal injury, property damage, or other loss. The foregoing shall constitute a release and waiver of all liability, claims, demands, losses or damages of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, on entrant or entrant's Child's account arising from participation in the Contest and any prize related activities. By accepting a prize, where permitted by law, winner (on behalf of him/herself and his/her Child) grants Sponsor, the MLB Entities, MLBPA, and their respective designees the right to print, publish, broadcast and use both his/her name, portrait, picture, voice, likeness and biographical information as well as the name, portrait, picture, voice, likeness and biographical information of his/her Child for advertising, trade and promotional purposes without additional compensation or notice. The preceding expressly includes but is not limited to the possible electronic, video and audio recordation of the winner's Child and if applicable winner's participation in the Event; however, nothing herein in any way obligates Sponsor, MLB Entities or MLBPA to make (and, if made, to use) any such recordation (and, in refraining from doing so, Sponsor, the MLB Entities, and MLBPA shall not incur any liability under any legal theory). Sponsor's, any MLB Entity's or MLBPA's failure to enforce any provision of these Official Rules shall not represent the waiver of such provision.**

9. **LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY.**

(a) **Not Responsible for Errors.** Submission, accuracy, and completeness of official entry form (including answers) is the sole responsibility of the entrant. Sponsor, the MLB Entities and MLBPA are not responsible for any computer, programming, telephone, cable, satellite, network, electronic or Internet hardware or software malfunctions, errors, failures, connections, availability, or garbled or jumbled transmissions, service provider/Internet/website/use net accessibility or availability, traffic congestion, unauthorized human intervention or for inaccurate or incomplete publication/dissemination of information related to the Contest (including the questionnaire). Sponsor, the MLB Entities and MLBPA also are not responsible for late, lost, illegible/garbled, incomplete, damaged, inaccessible, corrupted or jumbled e-mail

transmissions/entries/answers, (all of which are void) regardless of cause. Sponsor, the MLB Entities and MLBPA are not responsible for any typographical, programming, mechanical, technological or other error in the printing of the offer, or the Contest generally.

- (b) **Tampering**. Any attempt to undermine the legitimate operation of the Contest, to tamper with the Contest, violate these Official Rules, and/or to seek to defraud Sponsor, the MLB Entities and/or MLBPA relative to participation in the Promotion (including but not limited to misrepresenting one's relationship to a minor child) will result in disqualification, possible prohibition from participation in future Sponsor sweepstakes/contest promotions and/or offers, and perhaps the imposition of other legal sanctions by Sponsor, the MLB Entities and/or MLBPA.
- (c) **Right to Cancel, Modify or Suspend**. If, for any reason, the Contest (or any part thereof) is not capable of running as planned for any reason including, without limitation, by reason of infection by computer virus, worms, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, fire, flood, storm or other natural cataclysm, riot, strike, civil commotion, governmental regulation or any other causes which, in the sole opinion of Sponsor, could corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Contest (or any part thereof), Sponsor reserves the right at its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Contest and conduct the Contest and select prize winners in a manner which is fair and equitable, including without limitation to not select any prize winners, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion.

10. DISPUTE RESOLUTION/GOVERNING LAW/WAIVER OF JURY TRIAL. To the fullest extent permitted by law, by participating in the Contest, you (on behalf of yourself and your Child) agree- that: (a) any action at law or in equity arising out of or relating to this Contest, these Official Rules or the rights and obligations of any participant and/or Sponsor, the MLB Entities, and/or MLBPA shall be filed in either the courts of the State of New York, County of New York OR the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York and you (on behalf of yourself and your Child) hereby consent and submit to the personal jurisdiction of such courts for the purposes of litigating any such action (and expressly waive any right of change of venue, *forum non conveniens* or any like right), AND ANY RIGHT TO A TRIAL BY JURY AND A TRIAL BY JURY IS HEREBY WAIVED; (b) any and all disputes, claims, and causes of action arising out of or connected with the Contest, these Official Rules, and/or the rights and obligations of any participant, Sponsor, the MLB Entities, and/or MLBPA, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action; (c) any and all claims, judgments and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred (if any), including costs associated with participating in this Contest but in no event attorneys' fees; and (d) under no circumstances will any participant be permitted to obtain awards for and hereby waives all rights to claim punitive, exemplary, special, incidental, indirect and consequential damages and any other damages (whether due to negligence or otherwise), other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses (if any), and any and all

rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased.
